STEWARDS OF CHILDREN/PREVENTING CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE

The Stewards of Children program educates adults to prevent, recognize, and react responsibly to child sexual abuse, and take steps to protect children. Participants will: hear stories from survivors of child sexual abuse; be introduced to the concepts of consciousness, choice, personal power, and relentless compassion, learn the 7 steps to protecting our children; receive a workbook detailing simple principles of choice, consciousness and personal power to understand the nature and impact of child sexual abuse; and be challenged to take personal responsibility for the safety of all children.
