Consider letting staff from MBCH's Church Engagement team assist your church to recruit a team of volunteers who will be trained and equipped to minister to those in need in your community.

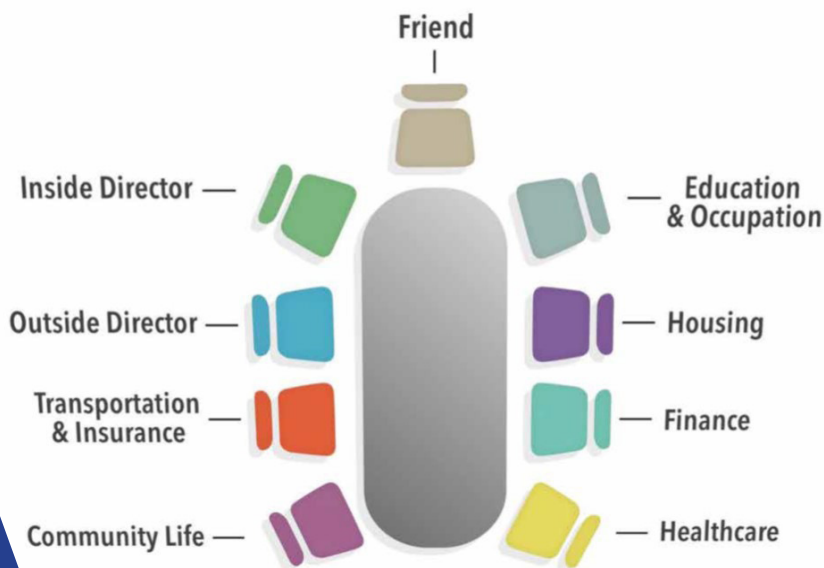
Tables meet once per week, and socialize outside of the meetings to establish long-lasting relationships and offer resources.
